

## eMobility Expo – MOW 2026 Opens Registration and Announces First Speakers

**On 10–11 March, eMobility Expo World Congress – MOW will place Andalusia at the international epicentre of sustainable mobility by hosting the largest trade fair specialising in the sector, with more than 6,000 delegates in attendance**

Through an outstanding line-up of authorities, executives from institutions, companies and organisations, the event will capture the major debates on the future of mobility and break down the transition to a new global order, placing the user at the centre of the discussion”.

eMobility Expo World Congress – MOW 2026 will feature six simultaneous auditoriums hosting twelve vertical forums focused on each segment of the mobility industry, along with four dedicated agendas for CEOs, CIOs, fleet managers, and the **Government & Manufacturers Summit**. This summit will bring public administrations and industry leaders together on stage to foster the public-private collaboration that is so vital to the mobility sector.
